

Coronavirus – Requirements when working at site

The following requirements should be followed:-

- If you don't feel safe don't do it contact the office.
- Social Distancing of 2m must be adhered to at all times. If this means that some work cannot be carried out safely, it will be postponed.
- Public transport should not be used.
- Engineers should travel to site individually. Do not share vehicles.
- Where feasible work should be carried out by individuals who can travel to site from home and return within a single day, removing the need for overnight accommodation
- Team size working within a single enclosed room should be limited to two individuals the room must be big enough to provide social distancing space.
- Teams sizes working outside should be kept to two individuals on a mast and one other on the ground.
- If other users are on the site they should be told to stay away from your working room (or in other buildings / rooms) until your work is finished. If there is any conflict, then leave site and inform the site owner.
- Engineers must ensure that hands are sanitised as they enter and leave site.
- Disposable gloves must be worn when en-route at public places eg filling up with fuel, comfort breaks etc
- Disposable gloves must be worn when transiting from vehicles to the place of work. If work cannot be continued whilst wearing gloves they can be removed. This is to ensure the hygiene of common touch points such as door handles is maintained.
- If an engineer starts displaying Coronavirus symptoms whilst at site then they should take the following actions:-
 - Isolate themselves within their vehicle.
 - Contact the office and advise of the situation, we will then work together to ensure you get home safely, and site owners are informed
